YOU **CANNOT** CATCH COVID-19 FROM THE VACCINE.



YOU MAY HAVE SIDE EFFECTS FROM THE VACCINE, BUT THESE ARE **NORMAL AND SHORT-TERM**. EFFECTS FROM COVID COULD HAVE **SEVERE AND LONG TERM IMPACTS TO YOUR HEART, LUNGS, BRAIN, AND MORE.**



THE VACCINE **PROTECTS EXPECTANT MOTHERS AND THEIR UNBORN BABIES**. THERE IS **NO EVIDENCE** THAT THE VACCINE WILL **AFFECT FERTILITY** IN WOMEN OR MEN.



MANY HEALTHY AND STRONG PEOPLE HAVE CONTRACTED COVID. ACCORDING TO EXPERTS, THE VACCINE WILL GIVE YOU INCREASED PROTECTION EVEN IF YOU HAVE ALREADY CONTRACTED COVID. **YOU CAN GET IT TWICE!**



THE DELTA VARIANT IS STILL ACTIVE IN CALIFORNIA. DATA SHOWS THAT **THIS VARIANT HAS A HIGHER INFECTION RATE** THAN ORIGINAL COVID.
